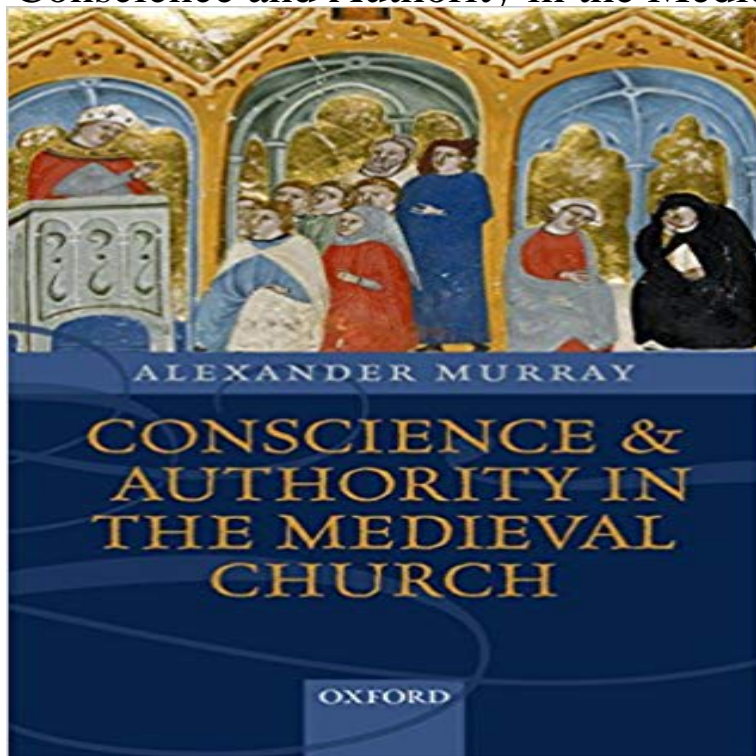


Conscience and Authority in the Medieval Church
