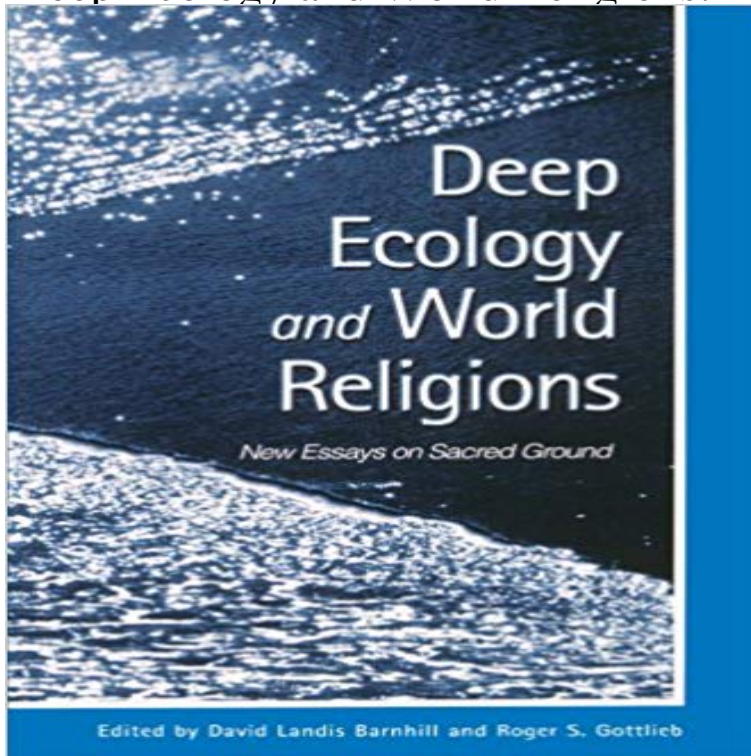


Deep Ecology and World Religions: New Essays on Sacred Ground
