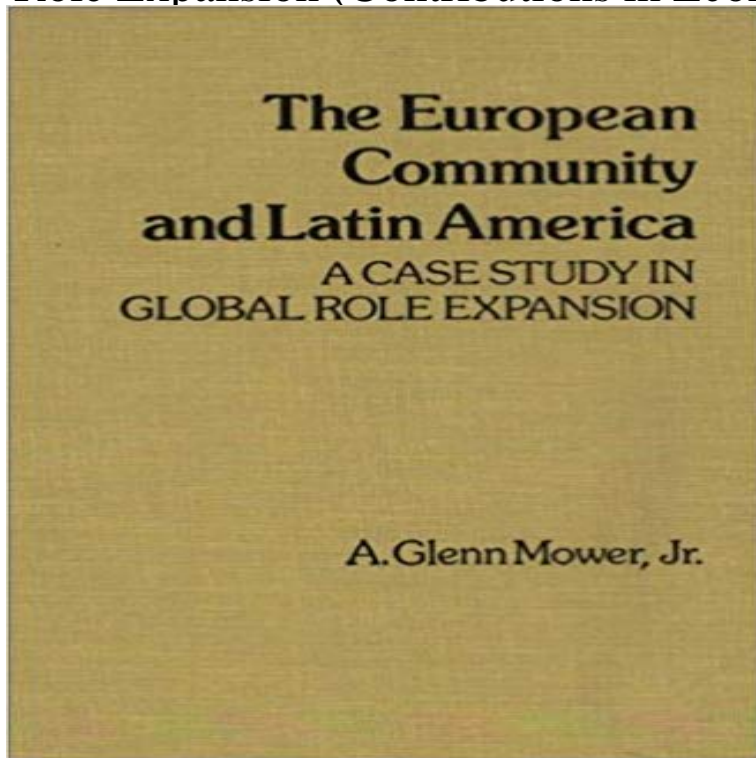


# The European Community and Latin America: A Case Study in Global Role Expansion (Contributions in Economics and Economic History)
