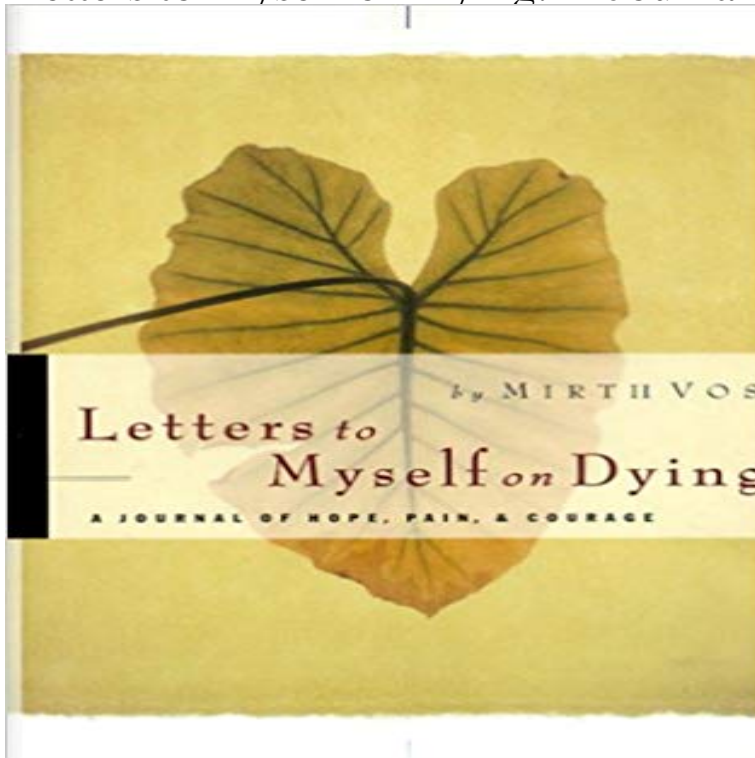


Letters to Myself on Dying: A Journal of Hope, Pain, and Courage
