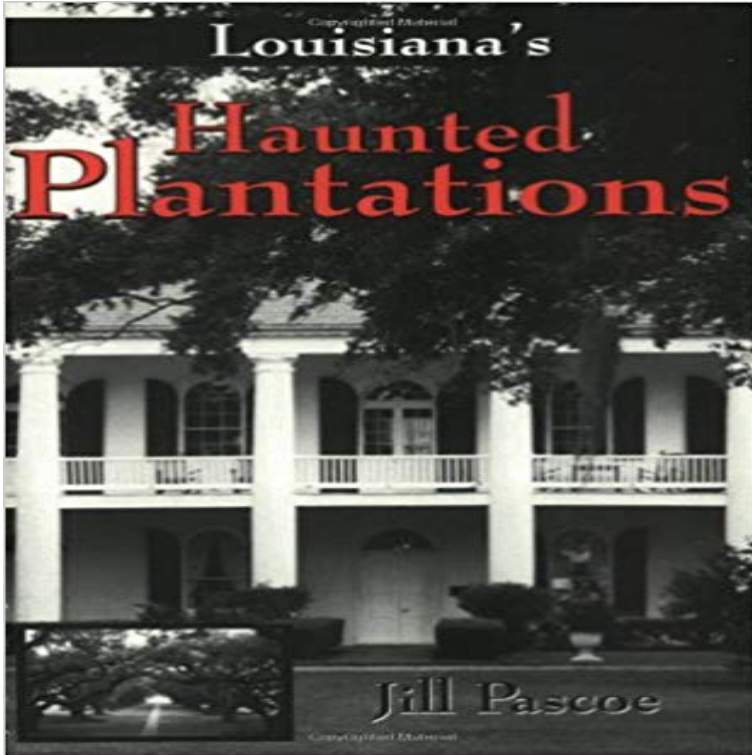


Louisianas Haunted Plantations
