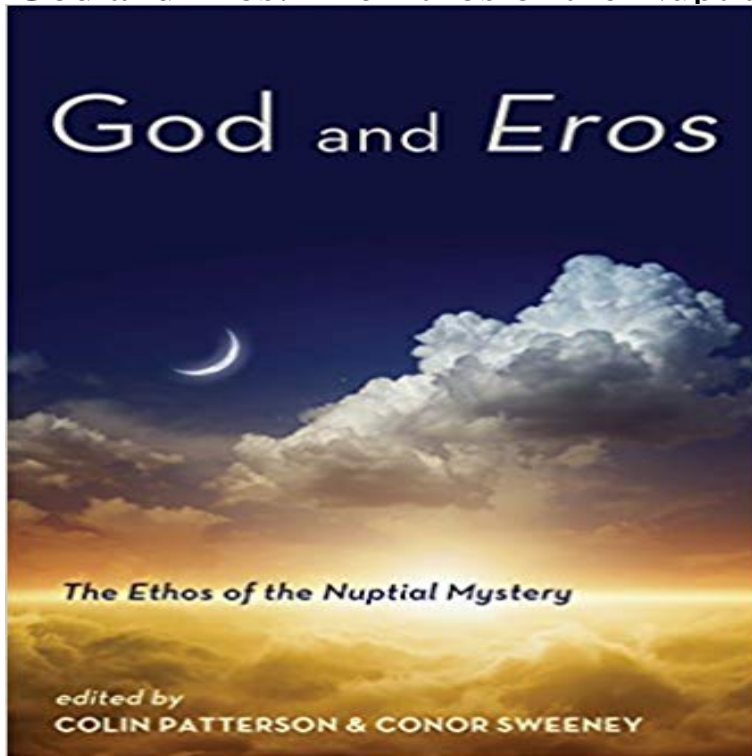


God and Eros: The Ethos of the Nuptial Mystery



What can God and eros have to do with each other? Body, sex, and affectivity, far from being locked in a lower order called nature, instead belong to a sacramental order that is permeated by the call to love. In presentations designed to appeal to a general audience, the faculty of the John Paul II Institute for Marriage and Family, Melbourne, approach this mystery through the lens of St. John Paul IIs theology of the body, with the goal to both introduce and more clearly illumine its major features. In particular, emphasis is placed on how a theology of the body is not just about sex. Rather, it is above all about how each and every person--no matter what her state of life--is stamped by the watermark of being-from and being-for.
