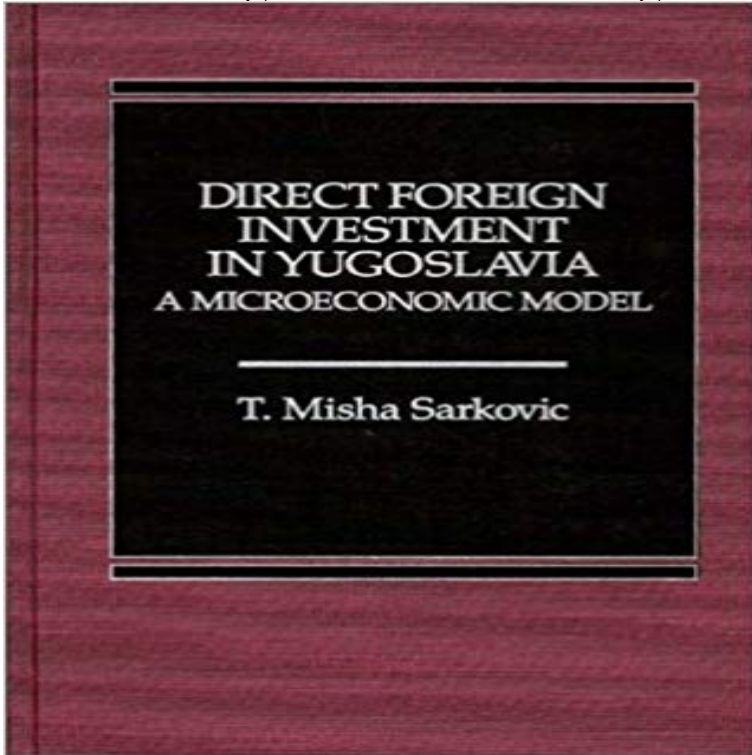


Direct Foreign Investment in Yugoslavia: A Microeconomic Model
