
Is Our Vision of God Obsolete? Often What We Believe Is Not What We Observe

The author states we do not need to abandon our belief in God to accept modern science and discovery. However were it not for human inquiry, we would still be living in caves. Religious scripture is a combination of literature, myth and superstition. Science and inquiry has and will continue to conflict with ill-founded religious myths. This is what intelligent design advocates fear most about science and discovery. His book addresses the issue of the sometime contention between science and religion

and suggests that each try not to tread in the others domain. He concludes his final chapter with the axiom, LEAVE GOD IN THE PEWS...AND SCIENCE IN THE LABORATORY! The author invites visitors to his website to review the various excerpts from his book with an open mind so that they may then draw their own conclusions about whether they want to rethink their own vision of God.
