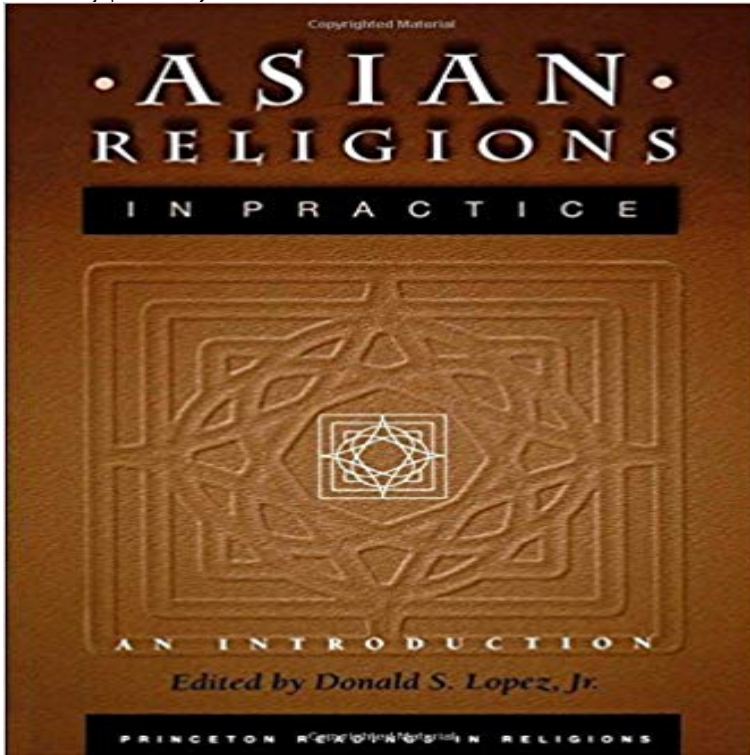


## Asian Religions in Practice: An Introduction (Princeton Readings in Religions)
