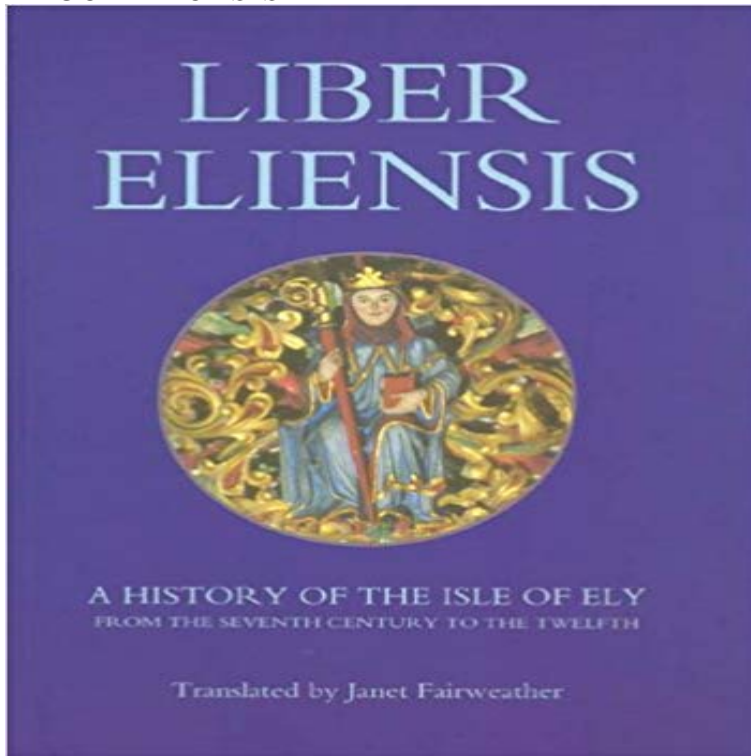


Liber Eliensis



This is the first ever translation from Latin into English of an important source for English and ecclesiastical history. The Liber Eliensis is an account of the history of the Isle of Ely compiled by a monk of Ely monastery in the later twelfth century. He uses evidence from the monasterys Latin and Old English archives, combined with chronicle data and biographies of saints and heroes, to tell the story of Ely in three parts. The first book, chiefly concerned with the abbesses of Ely (St Aethelthryth founded the house as a double house under female leadership), extends from the conversion of East Anglia to Christianity to the aftermath of the Danish sack; the second book covers 970-1106, when the Benedictine monastery was ruled by abbots, and includes an account of Herwards resistance to William the Conqueror; the third book starts from 1106, when Ely first became the seat of a bishop, and extends to the compilers own times, ending with the martyrdom of Thomas Becket. The translation, based on E.O. Blakes edition of 1962, does full justice to the compilers gift for story-telling and his wide range
