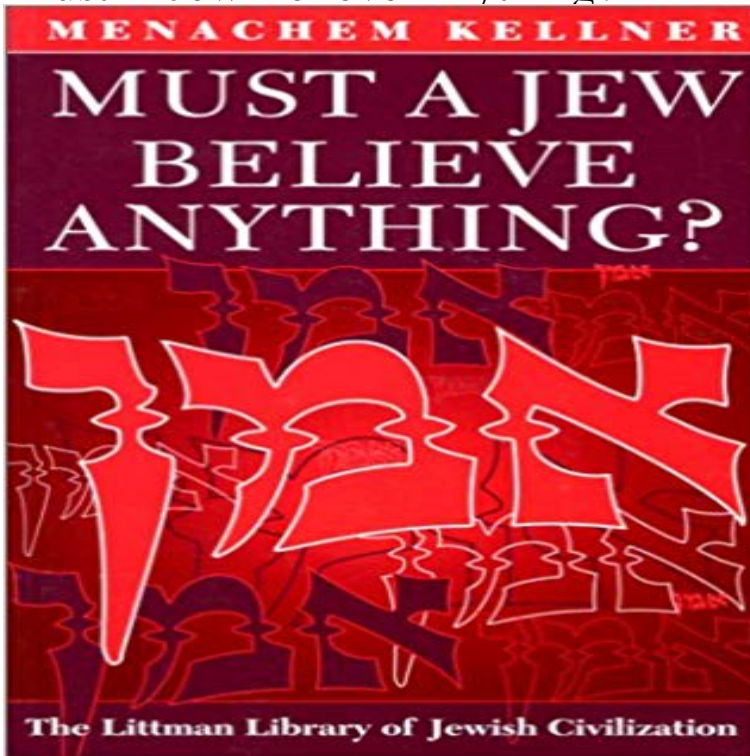


Must A Jew Believe Anything?
