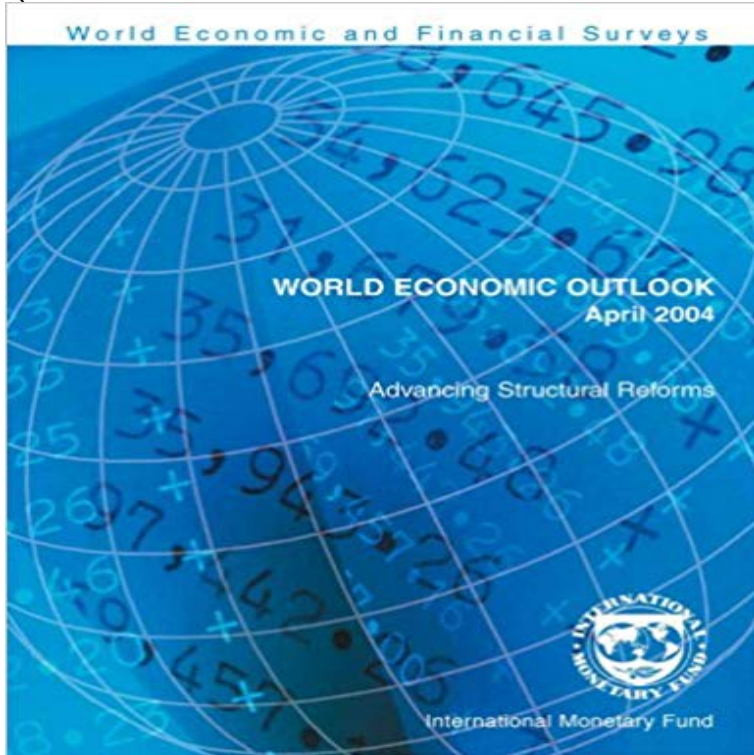


World Economic Outlook, April 2004: Advancing Structural Reforms (World Economic and Financial Surveys)
