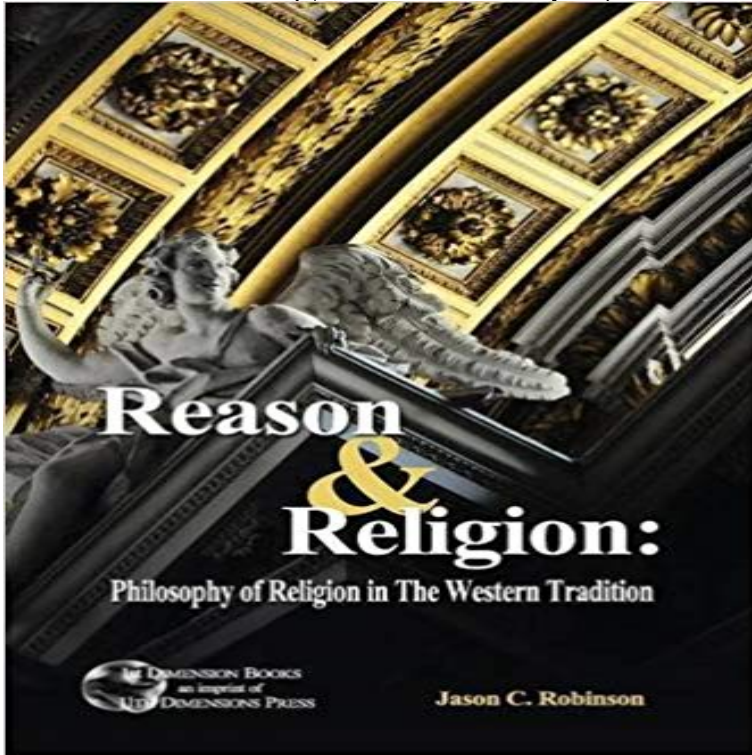


Reason & Religion: Philosophy of Religion in the Western Tradition
