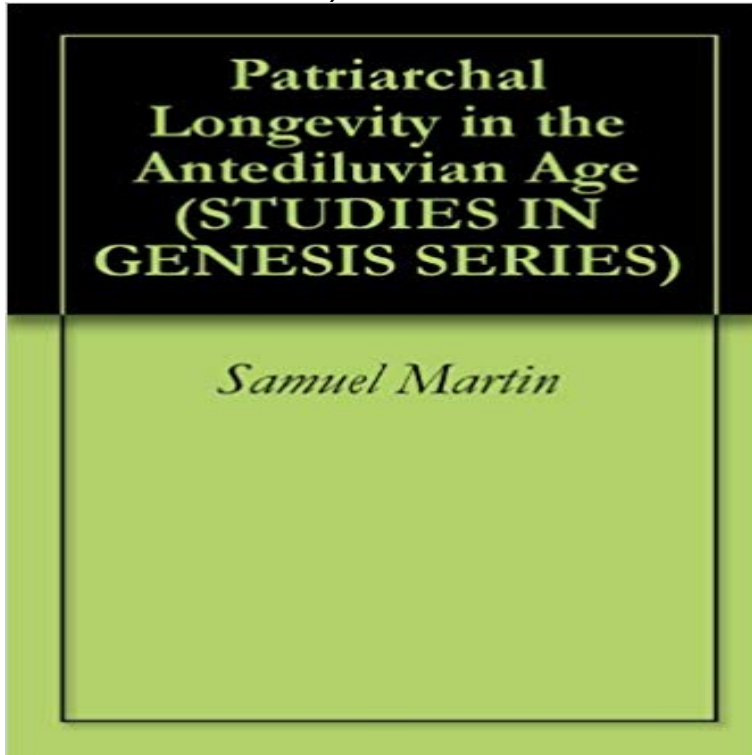


## Patriarchal Longevity in the Antediluvian Age (STUDIES IN GENESIS SERIES Book 2)
