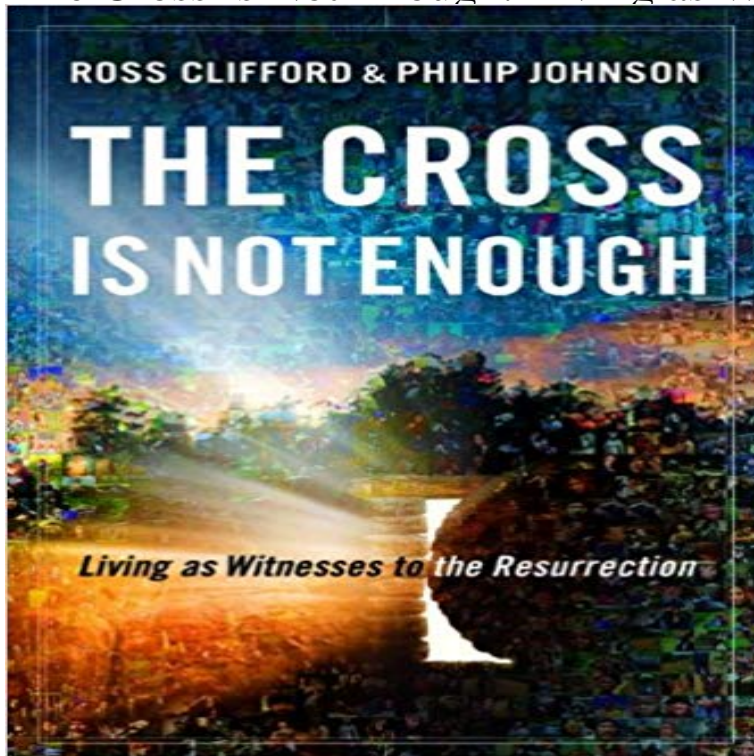


The Cross Is Not Enough: Living as Witnesses to the Resurrection
