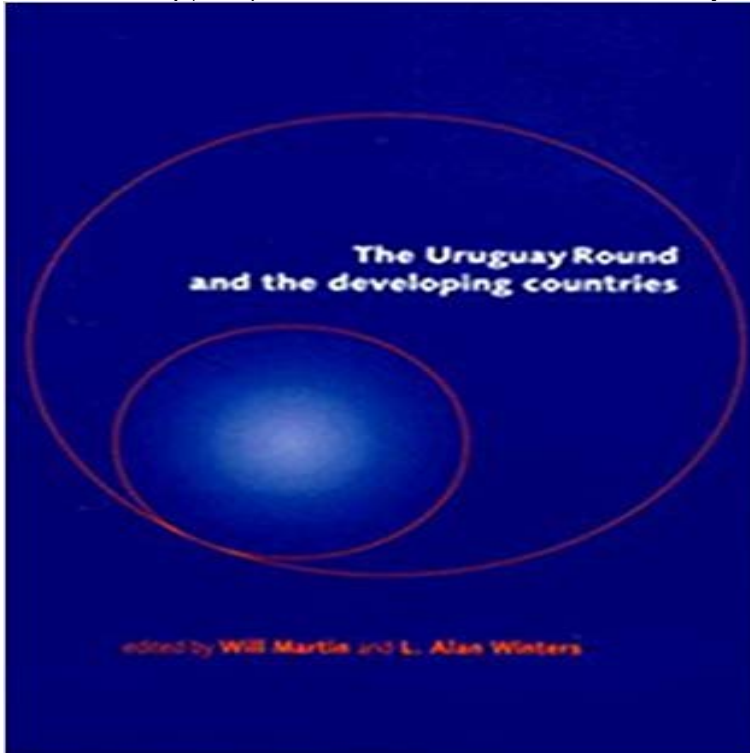


The Uruguay Round and the Developing Countries
