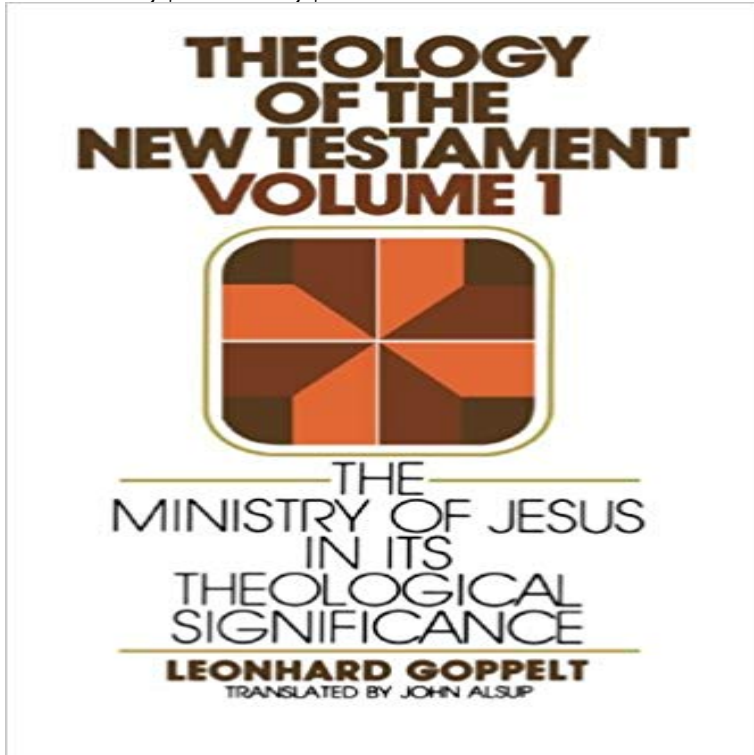


Theology of the New Testament, Volume 1: The Ministry of Jesus in Its Theological Significance
