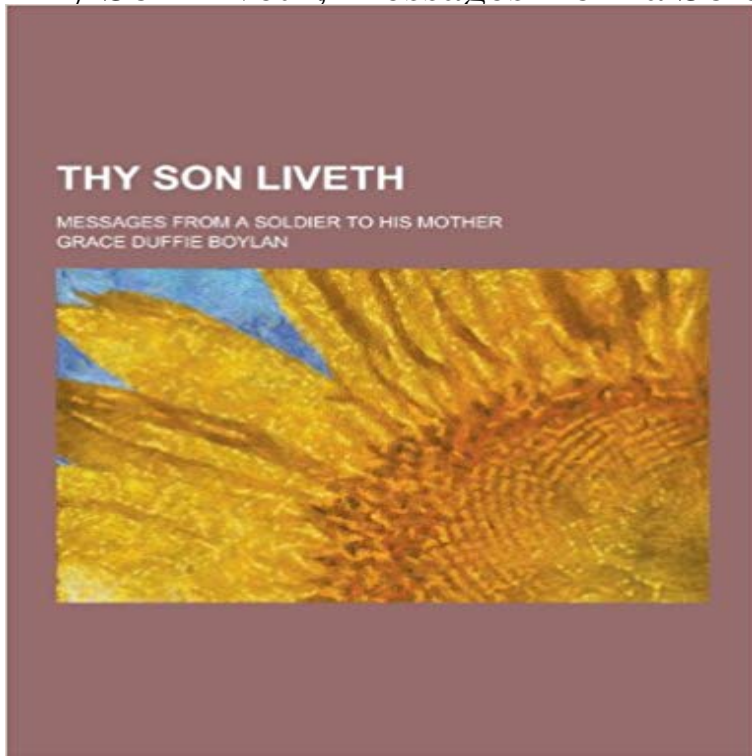


Thy Son Liveth; Messages from a Soldier to His Mother
