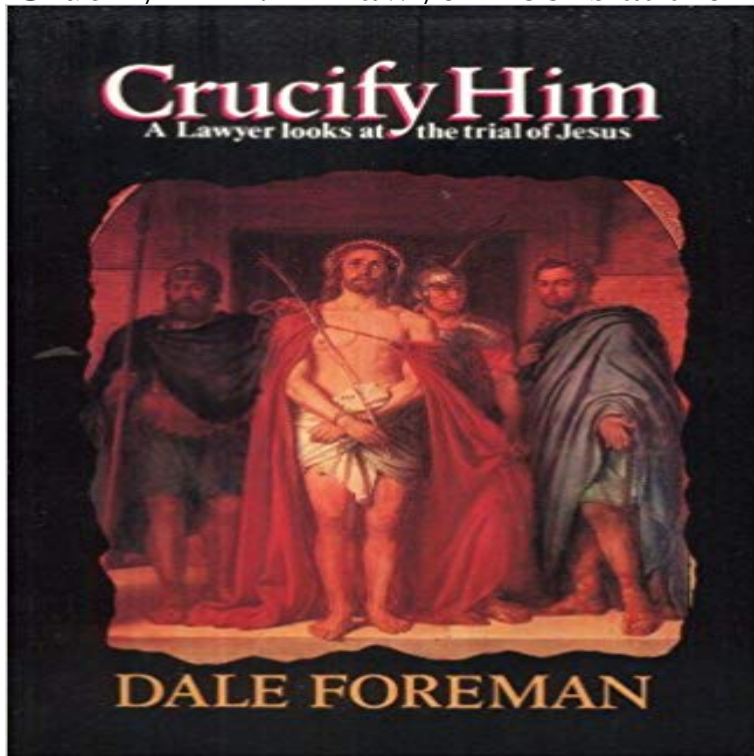


Crucify Him: A Lawyer Looks at the Trial of Jesus
