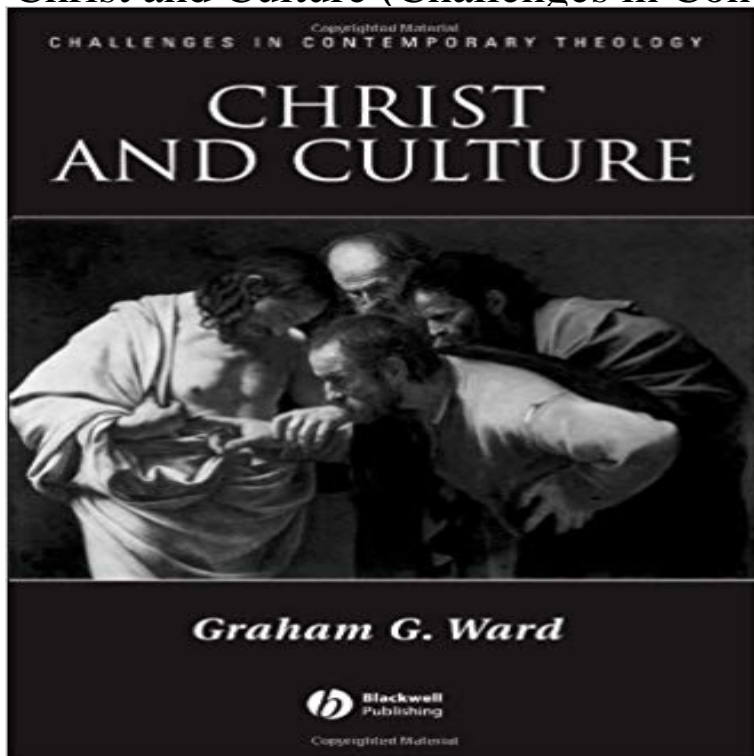


Christ and Culture (Challenges in Contemporary Theology)
